

Subject: RELIEF PACKAGE FOR AGRICULTURAL TUBEWELLS

1. The Authority is pleased to notify a relief of 33% reduction in KWH based charges for the bona fide Agricultural Tubewells in the Punjab Province. This relief package shall be valid for the period of three months (i.e. for billing cycle of April, May & June 2002).

2. The Director General (I.S)WCC shall work out the bill in the following manners :-

- a) The consumer shall be billed for fixed charges plus 67% of the total unit based charges.
- b) The rest 33% of total unit based charges shall be apportioned between the Government of Punjab and WAPDA @ 75% and 25% respectively.
- c) The relief amount chargeable to Government of Punjab shall be adjusted against the amount of electricity duty available at the credit of Punjab Government in WAPDA accounts as already being done against SCARP tube wells.
